Dear Sirs,

The World Minigolfsport Federation (WMF) has for many years been working for extending the knowledge of the minigolfsport into other parts of the world than Europe, and the WMF executive board decided some years ago to apply for membership of the AGFIS organization, which is one of several sporting bodies, that works on a world-wide basis like the Olympic Games organization.

One of the requirements for achieving membership of the AGFIS organization was to have at least regional organizations in 3 different regions in the world, of which Europe until now has been the most active.

In August 2004 in Timisoara, a number of delegates from different European minigolf member nations decided upon the first set of rules for a more focused European Minigolfsport Federation (EMF) and furthermore elected a group of people from different member nations, that should take responsibility for setting up this new European Minigolfsport Federation, with particular interest of European issues within our minigolf sport.

This group of people have been working hard since then with especially the registration issue, that basically was the key discussion at the EMF meeting in Timisoara.

The EMF organization is still in a construction phase, which means that costs are generated at some level, but no income is received from the current European member nations of the WMF organization, as we are waiting for the upcoming WMF general meeting in August to see, how the current set of responsibilities, cash flow, organizational groups and bodies will be separated between the WMF and EMF organizations.

Until now, all costs have been paid by the national organizations, to which the members of the EMF executive board is originating from, but this situation is not a proper long-term solution, as all the national organizations want, that all the member nations participate in the funding of the EMF setup.

The EMF board has therefore decided to ask you for a donation, which solely will be used for the most critical costs, that we have to accept during this phase of the EMF construction.

We are aware of, that many EMF nations do not have the financial capabilities to donate large amounts of money to our work, but every donation, small or big, will tell us, that You support our efforts, which basically just has to be considered as a follow-up on our common decision from the Timisoara meeting.
