Thanks for your visit her in Odense, it was great seeing you again.

I would just like to give you an update to the Mini&Golfi situation here in Odense.

We now have a confirmed sponsor for Mini&Golfi in Odense

The sponsor is the renovation company of Odense who are going to sponsor the following:

1800 € worth of materials for 5 schools (5*5 sets)

1 person ½ time for 5 weeks to create material to hand out to the students to bring home.

This material will contain information on recycling and minigolf in combination.

It also seems that the renovation company likes the project that much that the sponsoring might go even further.

So all in all – great new from Odense.

Extra stuff 1:

One of the teachers that has been running the pilot project has developed a new “game”

He lets the students shot targets for questions in the education.

This means that the students must hit certain targets on the way to the hole to “earn” rights to one or more questions (mostly math but can be used in any subject)

Extra stuff 2:

One very interesting aspect that we found during the first part of the pilot project was that the normal “soccer kids” was not the ones to gain the biggest success stories from Mini&Golfi.

It turned out that several of the kids that normally was spectators grabbed the opportunity and took ownership in constructing the obstacles and started tutoring the “soccer kids”

Extra stuff 3:

Why don't we create an combined webpage for Mini&Golfi – showing that this is an European effort, it's a really good argument.

The webpage should be able to handle the languages of all participating countries (translated info on main level – and only local language when deeper in the webpage)
